



PESTICIDE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

In compliance with Section 5(d) of Puerto Rico Pesticides Act, registration of pesticides and devices must be accomplished through a local representative of the manufacturer if the pesticide is manufactured outside the island.

The designation of a local resident representative or agent in Puerto Rico is required prior to soliciting the registration of any of your products.

The registration application form must be completed, signed and submitted by the designated representative or agent, resident in Puerto Rico. Each application shall be accompanied with the following documents:

- Three labels of each pesticide or device to be register (including all different contents that will be distributed in Puerto Rico).
- Official letter of representative designation.
- EPA approved labels (except for Section 25b Pesticides)
- SDS (Safety Data Sheet)
- Form 8570-5 (Notice of Supplemental Distribution) if necessary
- Spanish label (a translation of the original label, only in case of restricted use pesticides)

Note: All documents can be included in a CD (PDF Format), except the Application Form

Once the pesticide or device application has been approved, the Department of Agriculture will notify the applicant (representative in Puerto Rico) issuing a payment request letter for the corresponding registration fee. The fee is \$40.00 per product or device.

All products or devices have two (2) year of registration. It is the duty of the representative to submit the renewal application for registration in order to continue distributing your products in Puerto Rico. It is advisable to maintain the registration active in order to cover those pesticides still in the market distributed years before.
